## Parking

• Park in the back half of the South lot closest to the Fellowship Hall (south side of the building nearest the woods). Leave

the back half of the north lot for families to utilize during student drop off and pick up.

## Entering the building

 Volunteers should enter through the Kitchen door or under the blue canopy at the side door of the Fellowship Hall.

#### Arrival

 Please arrive by 8:30 am and check-in with Bro. Bryan in the Fellowship Hall.

#### Dress Code

- Dress modestly (no short shorts or cut-offs).
- Please wear your VBS volunteer t-shirt.

#### Schedule

• A schedule for the day with the rotations will be provided to you. Crew Leaders, you will be responsible for the movement of your group through the rotations.

#### Nametags

• All volunteers will be given a special VBS nametag.

#### Nametags for Children

- ◆ Each child will receive a nametag before they arrive at their assigned Worship Rally section.
- Nametags will be given at the Registration Table.

#### Section Packets and Crew Baskets

- Each class will be assigned a section in the Fellowship Hall for the Opening and Closing Worship Rallies.
- In each section Crew Leaders will find a Section Packet and Crew Basket. The Section Packets will contain a class list, coloring activity, and any correspondence that needs to go home with the children.
- Seat children in their assigned section. Check to make sure each child has their nametag on.
- Until Opening Worship Rally begins, lead the children in the coloring activity from the Section Packet.
- The Crew Basket is for you to take with you to the rotation areas and to carry the crafts.

#### **Dismissal**

- ◆ All classes will return to the Fellowship Hall for the Closing Worship Rally.
- During the Closing Worship Rally, a review of the day's lesson and the Gospel Presentation will be presented.
- Crew Leaders will hold anything that should go home with the children until the dismissal.
- Crew Leaders need to keep children in your section until their caregiver arrives to pick them up.
- ◆ At the conclusion of VBS, we will have a family "cook-in" picnic in the Fellowship Hall. All VBS kids, families, and volunteers are invited to stay and eat.





#### **Volunteer Roles**

- ◆ Crew Leader: Lead a group of children through the rotation stations.
- Rotation Station Leaders: Lead Crews of children through the Bible lesson, craft, missions, recreation,

and snack.

- Cook-in Team: Help prepare and serve the family picnic for the kids and their families at the conclusion of VBS.
- Students in 7th grade and up are welcome to serve! It's not too late to sign up for this ministry opportunity!

## **Prayer Needs BEFORE VBS:**

- Pray for every staff member and volunteer.
- Pray that the Lord will fill every volunteer position BEFORE VBS.
- Pray that God will give wisdom in final planning.
- Pray for the safety and health of participants, workers, and their families.
- ◆ Pray for the spiritual preparation of all workers. Pray the armor of God over every volunteer
