Grace and peace to you from our Lord Jesus Christ.

It is an exciting time in the life of our church. We have had one recent baptism and are in the process of scheduling another, so it has been good to see the Lord give spiritual life. He has also given life in another sense, as Tori and I welcomed our fourth child into the world a week ago (May 23), making that the third baby born in our congregation within the last year. God's kindness to us is evident.

There are several summer events that you should be aware of. First of all, right around the corner, we will have the World Changers staying at our facilities as they do work around the city of Pine Bluff. They will be here June 9-14. Secondly, on Sunday, June 23 we will have a cookout at 5 pm that will kick off an 8 week series. I am calling it "The Bible's Big Picture" as we study the overarching narrative of Scripture and how each section of the Bible fits within that narrative. Finally, we will have our VBS One Day event on July 13, so please invite any children you know to participate!

I have been meditating this week on one verse of Scripture I would like to share with you. **Psalm 119:17- Deal bountifully with your servant, that I may live and keep your word.** This verse, being addressed directly to God, could be considered a prayer, and I would like you to see 3 elements of the Psalmist's prayer.

- 1. His Petition to God- The Psalmist here asks that God would deal bountifully with him. In other words, he is appealing to God for grace. We must recognize that we are totally dependent on the Lord, and that if we are going to live faithfully, we need God's activity toward us to be bountiful in the blessings of grace.
- 2. His Position before God- The Psalmist identifies himself as a servant. As he makes this petition, appealing to God to deal bountifully with him, he is occupying a position of servitude. We must also gladly become servants of God as we seek his blessings. None of us are above servitude in his kingdom.
- 3. His Preservation by God- The result of the Psalmist's petition, that God would "deal bountifully" with him, would be the preservation of his life and his faithfulness to the word. There is a causal relationship here- it is the bountiful dealings of God that lead to life and faithfulness. God is the giver of life, both physical and spiritual. And he is the sustainer of life as well. And Christ is the Author and Perfecter of our faith. If we are going to continue to live and be faithful by keeping God's Word, we need the Lord to preserve us.


To summarize this verse, we see here that **servants of God depend on his gracious activity for life and faithfulness.** It is my prayer for you that you would assume the position of servitude before God, that your petition would be that God deal bountifully with you, and that as a result, you experience the preservation of life and faithfulness as you live and keep God's Word.
