Grace and peace to you from our Lord Jesus Christ.

Have you ever been overwhelmed with the glory of God? What I mean is, have you ever had a moment where the majesty, power, wisdom, righteousness, and just the overall grandeur of God struck you and left you speechless? I have found that this will happen to me in two contexts- when I am reflecting on what he has created and when I am meditating on what he has written.

There have been times when I am in awe of nature- a sunrise or a sunset, a mountain range or a canyon, a field of wildflowers or a forest of trees, sunbeams shining through the clouds during the day or the stars scattered across the nighttime sky, ocean waves or a rushing river, and so on. When I am rightly reflecting on these things, they cause me to praise the One who created them.

There have been other times that I am struck by something in God's Word. Maybe the meaning of a certain passage finally clicks for me. Maybe I notice the beauty of a given verse for the first time. Or maybe I am simply reminded of the truth of God's character and the glory of the gospel of Jesus Christ as a read, and though it is not the first time, praise for God is stirred in my heart once more.

The reason that those are the contexts in which I, and most likely you, have come face to face with God's majesty is simple- Scripture teaches that those are the places God has revealed his character. The revelation of God can be divided into two categories- **general revelation and special revelation.** General revelation consists of the truths that God has revealed to everyone, everywhere in creation itself. Special revelation refers to the more specific truth that God has revealed in Scripture, those things that cannot be ascertained simply by observing nature. Psalm 19 gives us a picture of both of these ways that God reveals Himself.

Psalm 19:1-2- "The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork. Day to day pours out speech, and night to night reveals knowledge." In the introduction to his book *Providence*, John Piper reflects on the glory of God in sunrises. He writes, "I used to look at sunrises when I was jogging and think that God had created a beautiful world. Then it became less general and more specific, more personal. I said, 'Every morning God paints a different sunrise.' He never gets tired of doing it again and again. But then it struck me. No, he doesn't do it again and again. He never stops doing it. The sun is always rising somewhere in the world. God guides the sun twenty-four hours every day and paints sunrises at every moment, century after century without one second of respite, and never grows weary or less thrilled with the work of his hands. Even when cloud cover keeps man from seeing it, God is painting spectacular sunrises above the clouds."

Psalm 19:7-9- "The law of the LORD is perfect, reviving the soul; the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple; the precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes; the fear of the LORD is clean, enduring forever; the rules of the LORD are true, and righteous altogether." These verses show us the value of God's Word, describing what the Word is and what the Word does. How often do we neglect such a valuable gift? If you want to know who God is and to grow in your knowledge of Him, spend time in the Word, and see these benefits begin to characterize your life.

Everyone in our church gets a unique profile. Your profile contains everything you want people to know about you. Your profile enables you to join a small group, RSVP to events, track your giving, update your contact information, change family details, or replace an outdated family photo.

Groups and classes are an important part of our church, and now you can connect with the people in them throughout the week.

Review your giving history or make new donations online or on your mobile phone. Simply sign in to look over your year-to-date giving, print a contribution statement or make a new one-time or recurring donation. It's always available and kept secure in an easy-to-use online environment.

Your privacy is very important to us. You have complete control over who can see your contact and personal information. Contact information is never public or searchable on the internet. Authorized staff will always have access to your profile information.

Our FirstKids Ministry will soon be using the Check-in system. This will improve safety, efficiency, and overall experience. We would like to adopt this same check-in with our Sunday School classes. We are hoping to take out some of the paper waste of the church. This will also enable to email or group texts to the classes and members of the church in the event of a power loss at church that would cause cancellation of the services.

You will receive an invite from the church office to Realm. Please consider accepting this invite. It is completely up to you. If you do not receive an email invitation, contact the church office to confirm that your information is correct, and we'll gladly resend the invitation.
