TRANSITION/GROUP TIME

BIBLE STORY STATEMENTS

- » God made the world.
- » God made day and night.
- » God made plants, trees, and grass to grow on the land.
- » God made lights in the sky: the sun, moon, and stars.
- » God said all that He made was good.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING

God made day, night, plants, sky, sun, moon, stars, animals, water, birds, fish, and people.

SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

Genesis 1:1-19

BIBLE VERSE

God made the earth and everything on it. Nehemiah 9:6

LIFE POINT

God made the world.

DON'T FORGET

Use a calm, quiet voice.

Focus attention on the babies.

Review parents' instructions and any medical information.

Put take-home items in children's bags.

Make a final diaper check.

Release children to authorized adults.



WEAR SUNGLASSES

Gather: Bible, children's sunglasses

- » Invite the children to wear the sunglasses.
- Stand near the window and look up in the sky (not at the sun).
- » Comment that God made the sun.
- » Look for and name other nature items God made.
- » Thank God for the things He made.
- Turn in the Bible to the Bible Verse. Read aloud: "God made the earth and everything on it. Nehemiah 9:6."

SHAKE INSTRUMENTS

Gather: Music; Bible, shakers or rattles

- » Sit with a baby on floor.
- » Play and sing along to "God Made."
- Suide a baby to shake a rattle to the music as you sing.
- » Hold the Bible and tell the Bible story statements.
- » Comment: "I like to say thank you to God and Jesus."
- Dead a baby to shake a rattle as you sing to the tune of "God Is So Good": "I thank You, God. / I thank You, God. / I thank You, God. / You're so good to me."
- Sing song again saying: "I thank You, Jesus."
- » Shake a rattle on each syllable as you say: "God made the world."

MAKE STAR ART

Gather: Bible, large index cards, large star stickers. marker

Do: Write the Bible Verse on each index card: God made the earth and everything on it. Nehemiah 9:6.

- » Give each child an index card.
- » Guide the children to put star stickers on their cards. Assist as needed.
- Say that the stars remind you of today's Bible story.
- » Hold the Bible and tell the Bible story statements.
- State: "God made the stars. God made the world. God made the earth and everything on it"
- » Thank God for making stars and the world.

STACK TOYS

Gather: Bible, colorful stacking toys **Do:** Place the stacking toys on the floor.

- Encourage a baby to choose a stacking toy to play with.
- » Let an infant look at, touch, or hold a stacking ring.
- » Mention items that God made that match the colors of the stacking toy items.
- Tell the Bible story statements.
- » Say the Life Point: "God made the world."
- » Hold the Bible and say: "The Bible tells us God made the earth and everything on it. Nehemiah 9:6. Thank You, God, for making everything."
