Grace and peace to you from our Lord Jesus Christ.

About a week ago, I got word that a pastor and preacher that I very much look up to has had a great moral failing and has stepped down from all pastoral and preaching ministry. This is a man that I do not know personally, but I have followed his ministry for quite some time, I have listened to many of his sermons, I have used some of his commentaries and read some of his books, I have quoted him from the pulpit on multiple occasions, and I generally just held him in high regard. So, when this news reached me, it was not only surprising, but also very disappointing.

I will not name the man here, and not all of the details have been made known surrounding the situation. I will not speculate about them either. But the church said that he was removed because of an "inappropriate relationship" with a woman, and clearly whatever occurred was disqualifying in nature. I must confess that often when things like this happen, my instinct is a bit prideful. I think to myself "I would never do that. This could not happen to me." This time, my thoughts were a little different. This man had decades of seemingly faithful ministry, he taught with sound doctrine, and he was one of the last people I would have expected to fall into this sort of disqualifying sin. And so my reaction was not, "This could not happen to me," but rather, "If this happened to him, it could happen to anyone." And the biblical reality is that it could happen to anyone, but it doesn't have to.


In 1 Corinthians 10, Paul uses the Old Testament example of the Israelites during their wilderness wanderings to warn the Corinthian believers to be on guard, and to not think they are above temptation, especially when it comes to idolatry and to sexual sin. In v.6 he writes, "Now these things took place as examples for us, that we might not desire evil as they did." He then recounts several examples from that generation before driving home the point that we should see their examples as a warning. V. 12- "Therefore let anyone who thinks that he stands take heed lest he fall." In other words, none of us should be so prideful that we think any manner of sin is impossible for us. It could happen to anyone.

But it doesn't have to. He follows that warning with a divine reality that serves to encourage us in the face of temptation. V. 13- "No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation he will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it." For the child of God, the one redeemed in Christ and indwelt by the Spirit, we have an escape when we are tempted. The Lord Himself is faithful to provide it every time. So when we are confronted with the reality of sin, and when we hear news of professing believers falling into all manner of sin, let us be warned and be encouraged. It could happen to anyone, but it doesn't have to.

The check-in kiosk is located in the gathering space of the Kid's Wing. Directional signs will be available to guide you and a volunteer will help with check-in. Your child will receive a tag, place it on their shirt, and keep the corresponding number to present at pick up time. At pick-up time, you will need to present this tag to their teacher.

Additionally, with the implementation of this new system, a policy change will be enforced: Children will only be released to an authorized guardian. This policy is crucial for maintaining the safety and security of our children.

I am excited about this new system and believe it will greatly benefit our ministry and provide a safer environment for the families we serve.
